Meshpoints is an initiative of Spacecubed Foundation, supported by Lotterywest, and is a collaborative network of organisations and individuals building a thriving innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem in Western Australia.

The Catalyst Create grant will enable ASTN to continue delivering a range of programs and events to grow and fast-track early-stage and growth-stage sportstech startups. In addition, ASTN will activate and connect the WA sports innovation community through a series of networking events and educate the sports market on trending sports innovation themes.

This work will build on initiatives delivered by ASTN over the last two years in partnership with the Department of Jobs, Tourism, Science and Innovation's New Industries Fund (NIF).
